Overlooking the Strait of Messina on the Calabrian hills there are lush vineyards that are sun-drenched from morning till night, in the typical coastal microclimate.

Name: IGT Arghillà red

Vines: Gaglioppo, Castiglione, Greco Nero

Vinification: Soft wine pressing with cold maceration

Soil: Medium mixture

Alcohol: 13 % Vol.

Serving temperature: 15/18 °C

Bottle: Bordolese 75cl

Food pairing: It is wonderful with red meats, cheese and wild game. Open about 20 minutes before drinking.

Organoleptic properties: It is a harmonious, warm, properly tannic and velvety taste, ruby red with violet reflections, and a typical, intense winey bouquet
