Vines:	Gaglioppo
Vinification:	Soft wine pressing with cold maceration
Soil:	Medium mixture
Alcohol:	12,5 % Vol.
Serving temperature:	15/18° C
Bottle:	Bordolese 75 Cl.
Serve suggesting:	16° C
Food pairing:	It is the ideal companion to first courses with meat and game sauces, as well as grilled red and white meats.

Organoleptic properties: It is a ruby wine , with a pleasantly winery bouquet, dry, warm slightly tannic taste with touch of liquorice.
